授業の主題・目標: Theme: This seminar will focus on some of the major global issues and challenges of the twenty-first century. Topics include Human Rights, Terrorism, the United Nations, Racism and Discrimination, Globalization and the International Financial System, Women's Rights, The Rights of Children, Workers' Rights, Religious Extremism and Ethnic Nationalism, Genocide and Crimes Against Humanity, Global Poverty, the Causes and Consequences of Conflict, and Environmental Issues and Resource Competition. Area, region and country-focused seminars are also available. Goals: At the end of the course, students should have a sound knowledge of a selected number of some of the world's most important issues and challenges and their influence on present day international relations. They should also be able to display their knowledge of, and opinions about, chosen topics in a writing assignment and in an in-class presentation (as well as brief weekly homework assignments).
